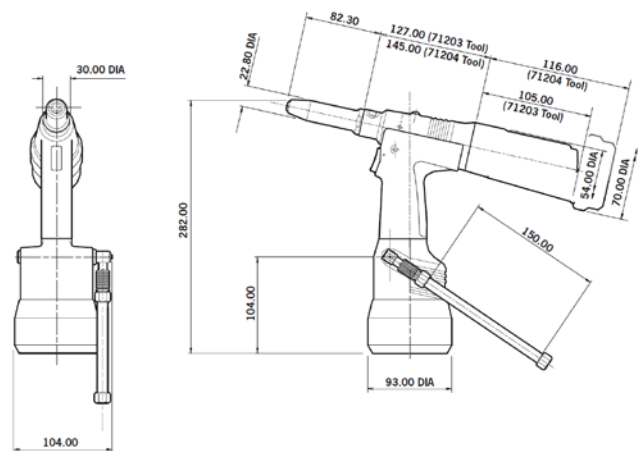
Placing capability
